YOUTH POSTER DESIGN CONTEST

ELIGIBILITY: Open to all Hawai'i students Kindergarten through Grade 12 or any Hawai'i resident under 19 years of age.

POSTER TITLE: "HAWAI'I ARCHAEOLOGY WEEK, OCTOBER 9 - 15, 2023" [required]

THEME: Preserving and Sharing the History of Hawai'i through Archaeology

FORMAT: 18 x 24 inches poster with a portrait or landscape orientation. Minimum resolution for scanned entries is 2700 by 3600 dpi.

CRITERIA: The winning design will be selected based on originality, composition, and relevance to theme. There will be two categories for entries: Grades K-5 and 6-12.

PRIZES: **1st Place (each category)** - poster showcased throughout Hawai'i during Archaeology Week, \$100 Nā Mea Hawai'i gift certificate (<https://www.nameahawaii.com/>), family admission to local museum, and printed copy of poster. Several runner-up posters will also be showcased.
